They came here to Ensenada looking for a better job because the salary in their state is really low and they cannot get a well paying job because they don't have an education. Alfredo is a salesman on the streets; he sells electric appliance stuff and blankets. He's salary depends on what he sells because he works under sales commission so some times he gets 150 pesos a day some times he gets less or more than that. Gricelda doesn't work because she takes care of her two kids and both of them go to school. Alfredo and Gricelda bought property on credit and they have to pay to the government 320 pesos per month. They live in a little room that is 3 x 4 meters square approximatly.
